After its establishment many activities and programs were organized from time to time in various domains. University has provided adequate facilities to strengthen the teaching learning process and to achieve its ambit as well. The State Government also supported for its infrastructure in terms of a building with fundamental amenities.

HRDC has a well-equipped Seminar hall, Lecture theatre (03), Library and other basic facilities. HRDC is effectively using the ICT based teaching learning methods with the help of smart boards available in the centre.

UGC had sanctioned 03 posts in the centre out of which two posts were filled in the year 2007.

The journey began with the organisation of Orientation Programs, Refresher courses and Short-Term Programs. After that we widened its scope with the introduction of "Faculty Induction Programs" "Gurudakshata" and "One week workshop" and now we have a huge teaching learning platform.

HRDC, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University has organized 36 Orientation Programs, 60 Refresher Courses, 04 Special Summer Schools, 04 Special Winter School, 16 Workshop, 28 Short Term Courses. Not less than 5000 participants successfully participated in these programs and about 2500 Resource persons were invited from different region of the country and imparted their knowledge to the participants.

U.G.C. has directed to HRDC for the conduction of some quality enhancement program like 4 Faculty Induction Program, 8 Refresher Courses, 4 Work Shops and 4 Short Term Programs.

In this connection HRDC Pt. R. S. U. has organized some programs as per the UGC norms

In the year 2022 – 2023 HRDC Pt. R. S. U. Raipur has successfully conducted some programs to meet the UGC target: 2 Faculty Induction Programs, 8 Refresher Courses, 2 Work Shops and 2 Short Term Programs.

Faculty Induction Program:

Human Resource Development Centre, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University Raipur organized a Faculty Induction Program "Gurudakshta" from 01July to 04August 2022. Prof. Kallol K. Ghosh was the course coordinator of this program and Dr. Arvind Agrawal was the course coordinator from HRDC.

The total number of participants was 44. They mainly belonged to the states of Chhattisgarh, and Assam. In this program 51 resource persons were imparted their knowledge to the participants.




OnlineTwo-DaysWorkshop: NEP-2020
