First Mentor-Mentee (MM) Interaction Meeting for the Academic Session 2016-17

The first MM interaction meeting was held on September 12, 2016 at 1600 in the cabin of the Mentor – AK Pati and it was continued till late in the evening at 2000. The following mentees, namely Shobha Kshatriy, Savita Tandan, Babita Nayak, Gaukaran Kurrey & Bhuneshwari Swarnapal attended the meeting. Three other mentees, namely Domar Singh Narang, Sebya Gartiya and Anjali Koram were absent.

Know each other Session

Since it is extremely important for mentor and mentees to get acquainted with each other, a session of *'introduce you'* was undertaken. The mentor spoke about himself at the beginning and thereafter each mentee presented detailed biographical/social account of her/him.

About roles & responsibilities

The mentor categorically explained about the role and responsibilities of all stakeholders in the mentor-mentee relationship. It was decided that each mentee will respond to messages sent by the mentor and also to the feedback inventories. The mentor also pointed out that he will give certain tasks to be accomplished by each mentee. He also pledged that he will try to solve problems faced by his mentee to the best of his abilities. The mentees were also advised to shun timidity and coyness while interacting with the mentor, other teachers and research scholars of the department. The idea is to establish a fear-free environment in the School.

Fixing up of short and long term goals

The mentor advised all mentees to decide and establish at the earliest their short- and long-term goals. The mentor explained to them what are short- and long-term goals? What they want to be in the future? The mentor informed the mentees about many future prospects and about the avenues that can be availed by them. The mentees listened to the advices and promised to act accordingly.

The art of communications

The mentor emphasized on the importance of art of communications both oral and written. He narrated his experience and informed the mentee that in general the students are poor in communication skills. The mentor explained to them how to improve communication skill? He advised the mentees to develop habits of reading English newspaper and listening to English news channels. He also explained to them how it is easy to get an access to top English language newspapers, now-a-days, without spending any money.

The mentor also explained to the mentees about the nuances of facing interviews, participating in group discussions and about drawing meaningful conclusions. He emphasized that all these could be managed effectively by becoming a good listener and a good learner.

Practice to work together in a group

The mentor asked the mentees to identify problems of concern and to find solutions collectively through exchanges of mutual ideas, plans and approaches. They are also advised to

assess the outcome their plans together and thinking of using alternative plans to solve problems.

Question-answer session

The mentees asked questions without any hesitation from issues ranging from how to write good answers in exams, how to get good marks, how to concentrate while studying, how to develop positive attitudes and to good behavioral mannerisms. The mentor answered all these questions and queries to the satisfaction of the mentees.

Conclusion

The entire 4-hour long mentor-mentee interaction session flid as if only 10 minutes had elapsed. None of the mentees were in hurry to close the session that was extremely fruitful according to the opinion of the mentor. The mentor mentioned to the mentees, prior to the closing of the session, that they can approach the mentor any time either walking into his cabin or through social media platforms (24/7). The mentor conveyed his sincere thanks to all mentees for their active participation in the first mentor-mentee interaction meeting.





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
