As per UGC Regulation 2021 all the vacant teaching position are in the process of advertisment by the University and to be filled very soon.

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







COURSE WISE RESPONSE PERCENT




SCORE OF A, B, C & D FACULTIES BY MA IN RURAL DEVELOPMENT & PG DIPLOMA




OVERALL SCORE OF A, B, C & D FACULTIES



SCORE OF A, B, C & D FACULTIES RESPONSE PERCENT BY MA STUDENTS


