## **About University**

Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University is Chhattisgarh's large stand oldest institution of higher education, founded in 1964, and named after the first Chief Minister of erstwhile Madhya Pradesh. The University has a sprawling campus in the western part of the capital of Chhattisgarh, Raipur. The campus of University is spread in our 207 acres of land. There are Twenty-Nine teaching departments in the University. A variety of self financed courses have been initiated in some departments. The total number of employees is 700, who provide the administrative support at different levels.

## **About School of Studies in Geography**

The School of Studies in Geography (Estd. 1 Nov.1965) is one of the five oldest Departments (School of Studies) of the University. The School of Studies in Geography is admitting about 100 students in M.A./M.Sc. and Ph.D. courses every year. This has been pioneered in starting M. Phil. Course (Started 1976) and is one of less than a dozen Geography Departments of the country running M. Phil. Our 53 students have succeeded in the National level examination NET and 25 students in JRF. So, further faculty of the S.o.S. has successfully guided 130 students for Ph.D. degree and 4 have submitted their Ph.D. theses and 25 are working for Ph D. More than 530 students have passed out M. Phil. The focal areas of research are Agriculture Geography, Regional Development and Planning, Resource Development, Population Geography, Urban Studies and Social Geography. Initiatives for development of facilities and courses in Remote Sensing and GIS are underway.

The Faculty and Research Scholars have published 31 books and about 500 Research Papers and Completed 21 Projects. There is Alumni Association formed in 2013 (Registration No. C.G. State 4441). Various alumni of this S.o.S are now holding important positions in the Government (IAS/IPS/SAS/SPS etc.) and educational institutions (Vice Chancellors, Principals, Professors/Asst. Professors/School teachers). Geography Academic Forum of students since 2009 under which academic activities like Invited lectures and Seminars are organized from time to time, The Teachers-Parents Meet is organized regularly.


