

ORDINANCE No. 123

P.G. DIPLOMA IN FUNCTIONAL (PRAYOJANMULAK) HINDI

1. This course will be based on the practical use of Hindi language in different spheres of day-to-day life.
2. A candidate, who after passing his/her Bachelor's degree or the third year B.E. examination or the First M.B.B.S. examination or any equivalent examination, has completed a regular course of study in the University Teaching Department or in any college affiliated to the University for one academic year, shall be admitted to the P.G. Diploma in Functional (Prayojanmulak) Hindi examination. Provided however, candidates studying for their Postgraduate degree may also join this course and take the examination simultaneously with the other examination. There shall be no bondage of percentage of marks at the graduate level for admission to this course.

The students of this course will be treated as casual and shall not be entitled to the privileges and facilities accorded to the regular students.

1. The examination shall consist of three written papers (each carrying 100 marks) of three hours duration each and a project and viva (100 marks).
1. Candidates securing 60% or more marks in the aggregate of four papers shall be declared to have passed in the First class, those obtaining less than 60% but not less than 48% in the Second class and those obtaining less than 48% but not less than 36% in the Third class.
