ORDINANCE NO. 111

P.G. Diploma in Environmental Science

- (1) The course for the P.G. Diploma will be divided into two semesters covering one academic session only. Each semester normally comprise 90 (ninety) working days.
- (2) Eligibility :
  - (a) M.Sc. In Chemistry/Biochemistry/Microbiology/Botany/Zoology/Physics/Bioscience/Biotechnology/Geology

Minimum percentage required is 50% of RSU University or any other University/Deemed University/Institute recognized by the University.

Admission to the courses will be given to the candidates strictly on merit. The merit will be prepared after an aptitude test followed by group discussion and personal interview. The details will be finalised by the department, approval of Vice-chancellor taken and published every year in the prospectus.
- (3) English is the only medium of instruction and examination for this course.
- (4) In order to organize extracurricular activities, the students of the course will have a chemical society.
- (5) The department will have a placement cell.
- (6) The department will have an Alumni Association in order to have interaction with those who have graduated from this department.
- (7) Examination fee, admission fee and other fee will be in accordance with decision of the department/university for the said course from time to time.
- (8) A student of this programme will not be permitted to take up any other course simultaneously. However, restriction shall not be applicable to the students of language, certificate course, computer classes or remedial classes.

Scheme of Examination:

The examination of first semester shall consist of four(04) theory papers of 100 marks each of which 80 marks shall be for university examination and 20 marks for internal assessment. Two tests of 20 marks each and one make u test for each course shall be held on the dates specified by the Head/coordinator of the Department/School of Studies. The best average marks of the tests will be counted as the award of internal assessment.

The second semester will consist in four (04) theory papers of 100 marks each of which 80 marks shall be for University examination and 20 marks for internal assessment.

Second semester will consist industrial training of four weeks. The candidates will submit a project report followed by evaluation and viva. The total marks for this is 200. Out of 200, the training and report will comprise 150 marks and viva 50 marks. An external examiner will be called to evaluate and to conduct the viva. For 4-5 candidates one management expert form University/Institute/ Industry can be invited.

Ist Semester:

Four theory papers of 100 marks each.  
The break-up of each paper i.e., 100 marks.

(c) A candidate failing in to a maximum of any two course/paper of first semester examination shall be allowed to continue in the second semester. In the second semester the candidate has to appear these papers of first semester (in which he/she has failed).

The candidate who has cleared all the papers of first semester but failed in two papers of second semester can appear in the second papers as an ex-student in the next semester.

If a candidate fails in more than two papers he/she will be allowed to appear as an ex-student in the whole examination of second semester in which he/she failed. Such candidates (if passed in the examination) will be entitled for admission as a regular student in the next semester, if any.

(d) For such additional attempts the university shall charge a additional examination fee as notified by the University time to time. No candidate shall be allowed more than two attempts (including

original attempts (including the original attempt) in a particular semester. If that candidate does not succeed in two attempts he/she will have to leave that course.

(e) The result of the first semester shall be declared as pass/fail. The final result for the degree will be declared after the second semester. The sum total of all the marks secured by the candidates shall be counted and division shall be awarded as per University rules

- First division : 60% or above marks in aggregate.
- Second division : Less than 60% but 48% or more in aggregate.
- Third division : Less than 48% but 40% or more in aggregate.

NB: An entrance test will be conducted for the admission by the department. The details of test will be notified later.
