Ordinance No. 150

Certificate Course in Watershed Technology

1. The duration of Certificate Course in Watershed Technology shall be of Four months.
2. A candidates who has passed 10+2 examination in Science and Social Sciences of any board in India, which has been recognized by this University and has completed a regular course of study for four months duration in the school of Studies in Geology and Water Resource Management of the University shall be admitted to the Certificate Course in Watershed Technology Examination.
3. The course structure along with scheme of examination shall be prescribed by the Board of Studies in Geology.
4. A candidate shall be declared successful if he / she obtains at least 36% of aggregate marks. A candidate is required to pass in the practical and theory examinations separately by obtaining not less than 36% marks.
5. Successful candidates who obtain 60% or more of the aggregate marks shall be placed in first division. Those obtaining less than 60% but not less than 45% in the second division and all other successful candidates obtaining less than 45% in the third division.
6. An examinee who fails in theory papers or in practical/project/dissertation may appear in theory / practical in forthcoming two consecutive examinations on payment of fee prescribed by the University, as an ex- student without being required to attend the classes of regular study. Provided that a candidate who has submitted project report/dissertation and declared pass shall not be required to submit project report again while appearing as an ex-student.
7. There shall be revaluation only in theory papers.
8. Other provisions not covered herein shall be as per the University Ordinances No. 5 and 6.
