The workshop begin on September 5, 2006 at the Seminar Hall of School of Studies in Computer Science at 9.00AM. In his inaugural address the Kulpati, Prof. Laksham Chaturvedi has called upon the faculty members of UTD to contribute to the future of RSU by 2020 by their wisdom. Prof. O.P.Verma, the Rector, appreciating the workshop, expected to get some fruitful conclusion through it. The Registrar, Shri K.K.Chandrakar, while giving vote of thanks in the last of inaugural session of the workshop requested to evolve better system for University Examinations and Administration as well.

In the first session, the speaker Prof. Shashi Bhushan, Physics, highlighted the need of facilities for future development and their social impact. Next, Prof. J. L. Bhardwaj, Economics, giving global scenario proposed an strategy as vision for RSU. Prof.M.A.Khan, History underlined the transformation occurred in historiography during 20 th century and stressed to develop a nucleus for couching history for competitive exams. Prof. R.P.Das, Management questioned the possibility of any such dream and Prof.S. Saraf highlighted the future of Pharmacy.

Next day on September 6,2006 Prof.A.K.Pati, Bioscience giving work of his research group marked genomic technology as one of the needs of the time. Prof.S.K.Pandey, Physics shown his concern regarding survival of basic science subjects in the University. Prof. V.Rai, Bioscience narrated the worked done in the past, present infrastructure and future plan whereas Prof. S.K. Vyas, Computer science perceiving the future of IT suggested Computer Technology, software engineering emerging areas.Prof.A.K.Verma, Library Science informed new research areas like information seeking behavior of users and the concept of virtual Library.
